



AXOPAR 29 XC CROSS CABIN

Capturing the spirit of adventure. This all-new range of boats represents the culmination of living our adventure and listening closely to our customers.

Everything onboard, all you can see, touch and feel, has been improved and enhanced, while listening closely to our customers and without forgetting our origins and paying homage to the predecessor, the Axopar 28.

The Axopar 29 XC Cross Cabin is truly pushing the limits of the adventure boat genre while offering next-level multifunctionality and maintaining exceptional value for money.

One of the biggest surprises hiding within the 29 feet, is the multi-cabin under-seat storage area in the bow, with access to a toilet and wash-hand basin, which doubles as a 'temporary' full-length sleeping space for two.

The foredeck has been reimagined and optimized being more social, now able to sit even up to 8 people. The standard L-shaped sofa can be extended into a u-shaped sofa. With the hi-lo table and infill cushions the bow transforms into a full width sunbed instead. The forward facing sofa enlarges the social area and potential on the bow, creating one of the most sociable and enticing spaces we've imagined so far.





The hull design and all functions onboard have been vastly improved: greater visibility, unbelievable range and fuel economy, masterful handling and drivability, stiffer construction which translate to more silent drive. These are but few improvements among a plethora of innovations onboard.

The boats are functional and have an optimized layout. The walkaround deck, has been enhanced with wider flare and higher bulwarks for safer & faster movement from aft to bow.

On the Sun-Top (ST), the new U-Sofa layout integrates the main socializing areas into the bow and cockpit while leaving the aft deck open and usable for any onwater activities.

The pilothouse on the XC Cross Cabin is now noticeably more spacious with an incredible 360 view thanks to the completely new panoramic rear window, giving the passengers an unparalleled experience of the surrounding nature. The sliding doors have a complete design makeover and are taller and wider than before, allowing easier access to the inside of the cabin.



Enjoy easy access to the aft cabin through the back of the spacious pilothouse or through the large roof hatch from the aft deck. The practical aft-cabin also doubles as a huge 'multi-storage' space for transporting gear and equipment, or as an additional sleeping space for two.

Not only redefined hydrodynamics and improved efficiency, the hull itself is more defined, more fluid, and with a less angular stance about it. The bow section is higher with a more pronounced flair that will impart a sense of protection from the elements and maintaining its renowned ride quality, even in rougher conditions.

AXOPAR 29 SUN TOP

Where More is More. Just like on the XC Cross Cabin, every detail on the Axopar 29 Sun Top has been refined. At Axopar, we do not change anything without a sense of purpose. Everything new on board has been done for specific reasons, to improve functionality, usability, comfort and set an even higher quality with a new visual presence.

You can see the Axopar 29 is clearly made with the same Axopar DNA; however, looking closer, the new, bolder and more adventurous design language and attitude, combined with a wave of new and innovative ideas and fresh solutions, gradually unfolds.

The curved windshield keeps you protected from the elements, while the lowered floor gives excellent visibility and an improved driving sensation. The repositioned driver and co-driver seats allow for easy access from both port and starboard.

The innovative multi-cabin in the front can be equipped with a head, sink, and additional cushioning, making for a perfect space for extended stays out on the water.



The extended modularity on the 29 extends to the fore deck as well. With new layout options such as a u-sofa, and forward-facing sun beds, you can enjoy lounging in even more ways than before.

In true Axopar fashion, the helm on the Axopar 29 Sun Top is driver-focused and provides an uncluttered dashboard, with the essentials within hands reach.

Combining the multi-cabin and aft cabin you will house more than enough guests for any potential spontaneous adventures ahead.

Following the very successful Axopar 37 Sun Top with its sliding canvas roof, this feature has now been transferred over to the Axopar 29 Sun Top, to provide sun protection and still having that open air feeling and letting the sun inside the cockpit when you want. The sliding canvas roof is offered standard with manual operation, and optionally with electric actuator.

To make your home away from home, feel even more like home, you can choose the optional top-loading fridge and sink, so you can have an ice-cool beverage, and some snacks, all while taking in the sceneries.



Take full advantage of the 29's maximised travel advantages and explore beyond what you've before thought possible for a sub-30-footer. With the increased fuel tank capacity, up to 30% increased flue economy and increased storage spaces you will explore and discover new adventures and new horizons.

AXOPAR 29 CCX

Born from an ambitious vision and a curious mind, the Axopar 29 CCX marks the first venture into the market of center console styled boats, expanding the global adventure boat range. This model is a true crossover, seamlessly blending utility, comfort, and versatility.

The Axopar 29 CCX caters to a wide range of boating enthusiasts, from seasoned adventurers to first-time boaters, with complete freedom to choose between going 'full-on' fishing or selecting between several of the most sociable layouts out there. Offering the flexibility to handle both, fishing trips and social gatherings with its versatile deck layout, while maintaining the same modularity and customer centric solutions that this sports-weekender range is known for.



The Axopar 29 CCX is designed for increased weather protection, essential for long journeys to favorite fishing grounds or explorations that may require several hours of continuous travel in high cruising speeds exceeding 35 knots.

The console features a forward tilting, fully enclosed toughened glass windshield and side windows, offering excellent protection from tiring wind-chill, spray and rain.

The forward extending hardtop contributes to the boat's modern look offering better sun protection and, when needed, airflow for the driver through its integrated skylight located in front of the helm.



While delivering an unmatched driving experience, Axopar boats are known for their superior handling and performance, ensuring every ride is smooth, exhilarating and enjoyable, whether you are on calm inland waters or navigating open seas.

The Axopar 29 CCX combines the sturdiness and utility of traditional center consoles with Axopar's signature style. The Axopar 29 CCX is designed with the distinct needs and preferences of center console customers in mind, recognizing the subtle, yet important, differences that set them apart from recreational boaters.



The Axopar 29 CCX is designed to be fully customizable, offering several different aft deck configurations to suit a variety of functional preferences and requirements.



The foredeck optionally features a 19-gallon (74 litres) insulated fish box with a macerator, ensuring your catch stays cool and fresh. The fish box also extends the seating in the fore deck area and can be utilized with the optional hi-lo table and sun pad.

Behind the standard aft seat row, you will can choose to go with a dedicated 33-gallon (125 litres) bait well with clear top hatch and tackle station, complete with a fish-filleting and cutting board, freshwater tap and sink, and ample under-cabinet storage for reels, lines, tools, and other essential gear. The main bait well features an optional raw water wash down pump. Additionally, the portside fenderbox can also house an 18.5-gallon (70 litres) live well with overboard draining.



The hardtop can also be equipped with rod holder bar, radar, search light and also a spray hood to better cover the sides of the helm.

A 158-gallon fuel tank (600 litres) provides up to 300+ nautical miles of range, ensuring more than sufficient capacity for both inshore and offshore adventures. This represents a massive 100 percent increase in both range and capacity compared to the Axopar 28.



The Axopar 29 CCX 'fishing version' offers a full open aft deck layout, providing ample floor space and unrestricted headroom for rod fishing and landing those extra large catches.



A more athletic appearance with the raised bulwarks that also enhance offshore capability and safety while moving around the deck, even during intense fishing sessions.

The integrated handrails help prevent fishing lines from snagging and optional coaming pads offer increased comfort. The proven deck design, with purposeful walkaround side decks without steps and flush floor level for the helm provide better visibility and a safer look out.

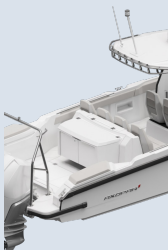

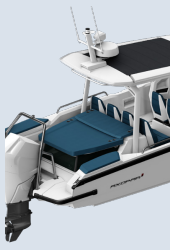

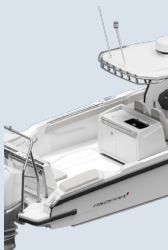
Optional aft bench (XC, CCX)
